June 21: Belle Meade



On the first day of Summer — Saturday, June 21, 2014 — <u>historic Belle Meade Plantation</u> will be the site of the next outing for the Nashville Section of the Mercedes-Benz Club of America. We plan to meet at 10 a.m. at the Visitors Center for our tour.

Following the tour of the grounds, we will have lunch for those interested at The <u>Harding House Restaurant</u> located at the Plantation. The <u>lunch menu</u> features a variety of soups, salads, sandwiches and Southern entrees.

You can enter the Plantation off either Harding Road or Leake Avenue, and there's plenty of free parking. When you arrive, check in with the Ticket Booth inside the Visitors Center at the Plantation and let them know you're with the Mercedes-Benz Club. Our tour will begin after everyone has checked in.

Belle Meade was home to a thriving equine thoroughbred business throughout the 19th century. Belle Meade garnered international fame by purchasing the first American-born-and-bred horse to win the prestigious English Derby: Iroquois (as in the Iroquois Steeplechase now held each May in Nashville).

The admission fee is only \$13 per person (\$3 off the regular adult admission), but we must let the Plantation how many will be in our group by Wednesday, June 18. ### Chalfant Motors: March 22, 2014

World-famous automotive restoration specialist <u>Jim Hery</u> hosted the Nashville Section for a tour of his restoration shop, Chalfant Motor Company, on Saturday, March 22, 2014.

It was awe-inspiring.



Jim, whose restoration of a 1952 Rolls-Royce Silver Wraith won Best in Class at this year's Amelia Island Concours d'Elegance, welcomed some 35 members of the Nashville Section to

his shop in Belfast, Tennessee. Stuart Doane of <u>Doane Motorwerks</u> in Ringgold, Georgia, was also at the event.

After a drive to Chalfant Motors in Belfast, Nashville Section members were welcomed into Jim's shop, where many incredible sights were on display.

Jim Hery is a *coachbuilder*. That term is not often heard nowadays. Coachbuilders are artisans who build custom bodies fitted

to a chassis, thus producing a finished automobile.



The Coachbuilders Encyclopedia describes it this way: "In the motoring days the process of acquiring a ne

way: "In the motoring days the process of acquiring a new vehicle was more complex. One approached a motoring brand who delivered to the customer only the rolling chassis. Subsequently the customer approached a coachbuilder, requesting a personal body design to be fitted on the rolling chassis." With this process, each finished automobile was unique. "I work on coachbuilt cars. No two coachbuilt cars are the same," Jim told the group. "And no two sides are the same: one side might be built by an artist and be all flowing lines, and the other side might be straight, built by an engineer. No two sides are the same, but then you can't see both sides at once!"

Jim's clients come from all over the world for his expertise in restoring the unique. Jim told the group that there are no "instructions" he can follow: "When I restore a car, all I have are pictures and photos. There are no plans or blueprints. I'm an artist, not an engineer, and that's where my skill comes in."


Jim offered a detailed description of the work for a Bugatti Royale in his shop. "Take a look. Everywhere you look, there's something missing," he said. "There might be a bumper, but there are no bumper brackets. It's job security!"

Jim, a history buff and <u>author</u>, has been in the restoration business for more than 40 years. He has restored numerous concours d'elegance, Antique Automobile Club of America and Classic Car Club of America winners, including 18 cars



shown at the prestigious Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance, two AACA Presidents Clubs and an AACA S.F. Edge Award.


