



# October 19, 2014: Mark Lambert

On Sunday afternoon, October 19, 2014, the Nashville Section makes a return visit to <a href="Mark Lambert's">Mark Lambert's</a> classic car restoration garage, Lambert Auto, on Charlotte Pike in Nashville. Mark will speak on judging classic cars - what judges look for, how scores are tabulated, authenticity and originality, and what it takes to have your car judged "Best in Show." The Club's visit to Lambert Auto last spring was one of the most popular events on the calendar, and I can assure you that you won't want to miss this event.

Located in an old firehouse on Charlotte Pike in Nashville, Lambert Auto specializes in servicing the <u>Full Classics™</u> along with other pre-war American and post-war European cars. Not only will you have an opportunity to take a rare behind-the-scenes look at the process of restoring classic cars to their original glory, but Mark will also answer your questions concerning what makes a car a classic, how classic cars should be restored, how they are judged and what trends he sees in classic car collecting.

Mark has been in business for more than 30 years, and his customers are located around the globe. Lambert Auto was featured, along with <u>Jay Leno's</u> garage and 23 others across the U.S., in author Phil Berg's best-selling book, <u>Ultimate Garages</u>. Mark is a veteran judge at several major Concours including the Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance, The Elegance at Hershey and The Glenmoor Gathering.

Getting to Lambert Auto is easy. It's located at 4406 Charlotte Pike, just to the east of the 46th Avenue North exit on I-40 in West Nashville.

Mark's presentation will begin at 1:30 p.m. on Sunday, October 19. Those interested in having brunch before the garage tour should plan on meeting at M.L. Rose around noon. Located right next door to Lambert Auto at 4408 Charlotte Pike, M.L. Rose is in the old Lavender Motors building. The restaurant specializes in craft beers and burgers, and the decor is automotive, including a number of pieces donated by Mark Lambert. There are literally dozens of draft and bottled beers, and while burgers are the house specialty, there are also soups, salads and sandwiches (and the "Super BLT" with avocado and Kenny's cheddar is an experience not to be missed!). See the website for more information; you'll see both lunch and brunch menus.

There is no charge for this event, but lunch or brunch is on your own. 

# Belle Meade: June 21, 2014

30 Nashville Section members and guests toured the National Register Historic Site of Belle Meade Plantation on June 21, 2014.

Built on 200 acres originally purchased by John Harding in 1806, Belle Meade grew to a working plantation of more than 3500 acres by 1860. In addition to being a working antebellum





plantation, Belle Meade was home to a thriving equine thoroughbred business throughout the 19th century. Belle Meade garnered internation-

al fame by purchasing the first American-born-and -bred horse to win the prestigious English Der-

# Beechcraft Aviation: July 19, 2014



36 Nashville Section members and guests toured Beechcraft Heritage Museum in Tullahoma, Tennessee on Saturday, July 19, 2014.


This was the Nashville Section's first tour of Beechcraft Heritage Museum, a distinctly original one-of-a-kind "living and working" aviation museum that traces the line-

age of the Beechcraft family of airplanes.

The founder of the Beech Aircraft Company, William



H. Beech, was born and raised in nearby Pulaski, Tennessee. The Museum itself started as the Staggerwing Museum Foundation in October 1973 under the auspices of the Staggerwing Club. In April 2007 the Museum became the Beechcraft Heritage Museum.





Today the 60,000 square foot facility houses more than two dozen aircraft dating from 1924 to 1999, plus many aviation artifacts and memorabilia.



The annual Chukkers for Charity Polo Match and Classic Car Show was held September 6, 2014 at Riverview Farm in Franklin, Tennessee.


Congratulations to Nashville Section founding member and former President Joel


