# Bellissima! Sunday, July 24

Sunday, July 24, 2016, will be "Car Club Sunday" at the Frist Center as members of the Mercedes-Benz Club of America will be the Frist's special guests for *Bellissima! the Italian Automotive Renaissance*, 1945-1975.

**Bellissima!** celebrates the visual dynamism and spirit of innovation characterizing Italian coach-built cars, concept cars and motorcycles produced during the post-World War II economic revival. Returning to the Frist Center after the 2013 presentation of *Sensuous Steel: Art Deco Automobiles*, automotive authority and guest curator Ken Gross has chosen 19 automobiles and 3 motorcycles from private collections and museums that are among the finest examples of Italian automotive design, including vehicles by Alfa Romeo, Biz-

zarrini, Ducati, Ferrari, Lamborghini, Lancia and Maserati.

The Nashville Section has arranged for early admission and a private lunch prior to the tour for only \$25 per per-



**son**. Because seating for the lunch is limited, this event is restricted to a total of 50 members and guests. We expect that this will be a sell-out, so please make your reservations early. You can reserve your place by sending a check payable to "MBCA, Nashville Section," for \$25 per person to MBCA, Nashville Section, Post Office Box 50291, Nashville, Tennessee 37205. We must cut off reservations on **Friday, July 1, 2016**, or as soon as we hit the 50-person limit.

The parking lot for the Frist Center is located behind the Frist Center, 919 Broadway, Nashville. The lot will open at 11 a.m. on Sunday, July 24, for the Mercedes-Benz Club, but will not open to the general public until 11:30 a.m. In order for the Club to be able to park our cars together in the lot please plan to gather in the parking lot behind the Frist no later than 11:15 a.m.

At noon we will enjoy lunch in the <u>Rector Room</u> of the Frist (on the left as you enter through the rear entrance of the Frist; you will see the Nashville Section banner in the hall beside the Rector Room entrance). We will be among the first visitors to see this one-of-a-kind exhibit when the galleries open at 1 p.m.
